



now stuck in another way again. winch can't even move it.




owner has to make a decision: stuck there or move forward.



owner steped on froze pond and think it very thick and strong. so he want to lower down the jeep and drive to other side of pond.




use 3 winchs to pull the stuck jeep up but still can't make a move



after many times attampt. owner decided to pull it OVER the pond.




now the ultimate icebreaker jeep is on the move

only 5m to the shore. the jeep's bull-bar broken off from winch pulling.




have to wait until next morning for more help. but the problem is ehe jeep froze in the pond already.

eventually the saver is coming...






